The East River Esplanade is Burgeoning!

The block-long lawn, the centerpiece of Andrew Haswell Green Park (AHG), is soon to become a prized destination of our waterfront at E. 61st Street at the East River. As you enjoy the promenade these days, you'll



come upon the construction equipment in the river along that stretch.

And, Mayor de Blasio recently announced that he has allocated

\$284 million for the rehabilitation of a large section of the Esplanade. Meanwhile, the East Midtown Greenway - a 1.5-acre public space stretching from East 53rd to 61st Streets along the waterfront, with accessible public spaces and safe bicycle paths - is proceeding apace. Both AHG and the Greenway are scheduled to open by the end of 2022. All in all, some very good news indeed!

Remember, Election Day is Tuesday, June 22


Update from the ESNA Beautification Committee.

Our activities for 2021 continued to be curtailed due to the social restrictions imposed



by the pandemic. However, we are pleased to report that the NYC Parks Department has recently planed four new trees on E. 66th Street between York and First Avenues – our urban forest continues to thrive! If you

see a street tree that appears to be dead or notice a tree bed that lacks a tree, please phone ESNA at 212 713-5826. We'll promptly pass it on to the City Parks Department. And thank you in advance!



New Plan for the Queensboro Bridge South Outer Roadway: Conversion to Pedestrian Only

- 1. Add fencing to roadway to protect pedestrians (as exists on all other NYCDOT East River Bridge pedestrian paths)
- 2. Add gates to both sides of bridge to allow access for maintenance vehicles, but prevent general use traffic.
- 3. Improve pedestrian connections to new path, including new crosswalks and other safety improvements on both sides of bridge. The new design will take into account maintenance and marathon requirements.
- 4. Updates to wayfinding and signage to reinforce that North Outer Roadway should be bike-only.
- 5. Traffic study to determine additional supportive changes to traffic patterns on bridge, or on bridge approaches to minimize traffic disruptions.
- 6. Completion date late 2022!
