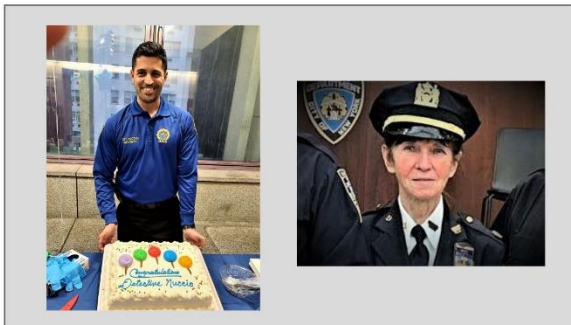
Welcome Back, Ol' Friend.

Hospital for Special Surgery (HSS) developing Kellen Tower

The new 12-story building on a platform over the FDR Drive at East 71st Street will provide increased space for advanced musculoskeletal care. It will physically connect to the ambulatory Pavilion Building and has a new bridge connection to the Main Hospital. The new building will also allow for modernization of the HSS Main Campus including an increase in the number of private rooms and less congestion. Work began in late 2021 and is expected to be complete in 2024. In consideration of the temporary disruption on the Esplanade, HSS shall make improvements to the pedestrian Esplanade walkway between 72nd and 78th streets.
