Updates on the Queensboro Bridge for Pedestrians and Bike Riders



On April 3, 2024, the Transportation Committee of Community Board 8 heard a detailed presentation from the NYC Department of Transportation on the North and South Outer Roadways of the Bridge.

Highlights of the presentation: The Upper Deck of the Queensboro Bridge is scheduled for completion in the summer/fall of 2024. The South Outer Roadway will have some changes and will now be used for pedestrians only and should be completed in summer/fall of 2024. The North Outer Roadway will have some striping and signage changes and should also be completed summer/fall of 2024. Will be used for bicyclists only.

Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center

Memorial Sloan Cancer Center is tearing down their existing 2 buildings on York Avenue between E. 66 & E. 67 Streets. Demolition is expected to be complete by the end of 2025. The new building on York Avenue, called the Pavilion, will hook up with the existing building with a 75-foot-high sky-bridge. The building will be 598 ft. tall and have 28 operating rooms and 206 single patient rooms, as prescribed by law. There will be a Community Working Group, meeting monthly, composed of residents and the hospital and construction workers, to discuss any problems during the project. The Hospital has agreed the building will be built by union labor. It should be completed by 2030.
