and the garden is available for relaxing. They are thrilled to be sharing their enthusiasm for history

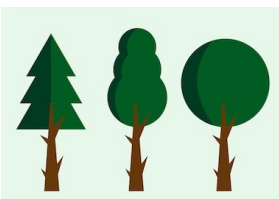

## 19<sup>th</sup> Precinct and Bikes/Mopeds

As NYC continues its effort to regulate the booming moped and e-bike industry, the latest police data reveals that the 19th Precinct on the Upper East Side issued the most moped and e-bike summonses in Manhattan for 2025. And the number of vehicles impounded continues to grow.

Since the start of 2025, the upper Manhattan precinct has doled out 1,650 summonses for moving violations to e-bike and moped operators. The enforcement addresses a significant 100% increase in e-bike collisions this year so far compared to the same period in 2024.
